The suitable candidate will support us by:

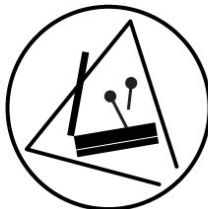
- Attending and planning regular rehearsals to prepare for performances and generate ideas for new musical pieces
